

Medication and opioid misuse, including addiction and overdose, is an increasing problem with children and young adults.

Learn how to keep your loved ones of all ages safer with these medication safety tips:

- Use medication only as directed by a doctor or pharmacist.
- Store all medications in a safety lockbox or secured area.
- > Dispose of expired medication or medication that is no longer prescribed for anyone in the household.
 - Disposal options: Check with your local police department or pharmacy for options to safely dispose of unused medicines.

Begin conversations with your children about their feelings:
