Psychopharmacology Continuity Clinic: (1) One-half day per week first 6 months, (2) One-half days per week last 6 months, (Year 1) at PCH  
 (1) One entire day per week all year, (Year 2) at PCH

Psychotherapy Continuity Clinic: (1) One-half day per week all year, (Years 1, 2) at PCH

- School: (1) day week, 1 month
- Psychiatric ED: (1) day week, 5 months
- Community: (1) day week, 6 months
